



## Liquor Sampling and Sales at the Cannery Farmers' Market

A distiller, brewery or winery (referred to as Liquor Vendor) can participate at the Cannery Farmers' Market upon application approval from the Market Manager and completion of the requirements of LCLB (Liquor Control and Licensing Branch). Please see information below.

1. Liquor Vendor must have an onsite store endorsement and provide a copy to the Market Manager. You might have received this when you applied for manufacturing to the LCLB or it is something that can be requested through the LCLB.
2. Liquor Vendor must apply on OneStop for Market Event Permission and advise the Market Manager when permission has been granted.

This application must be received by LCLB a minimum of 2 weeks in advance of a market. Our society number also known as identifier needs to be entered on the online application. It is **S-0021929**.

# Submit Market Events - CHECKLIST

The following is useful information for submitting a Market event:

- You need a BCeID account registered with OneStop. If you do not have a registered account, please contact the Liquor Control and Licensing Branch:
  - Call toll-free from anywhere in British Columbia except Victoria: 1 888 544-0443
  - From Victoria and anywhere outside British Columbia: 250 952-7039
- If you hold a Manufacturer licence with an on-site store endorsement, you will be able to submit notice of Market events.
- Ensure you have the details to submit your event, as you cannot save and return to it later.
