### Reflective Cannery Mindmap


We encourage teachers to create a Reflective Mindmap with their students allowing them to reflect on what they learned about the Cannery and how it relates to them personally.






## Create your Own Salmon

Step 1: Using cardboard, cut out salmon shaped bodies for your class

Step 2: Have your students paint each of their own cardboard salmon

Step 3: Using a pair of scissors, make multiple 1 cm notches (cuts) along the top and bottom of the salmon's body

Step 4: Using pre-cut string, have your students practice their fine motor skills by lacing string between the notches to create a scales affect.
