
Gulf of Georgia Cannery **National Historic Site** Discovery Tour (Gr 7+ and mixed age groups)





THEME

The Gulf of Georgia Cannery Society honours the importance of Canada's West Coast fishing history by sharing stories of the fishing industry and fishing communities through exhibitions, collections, and programs and events.

DESCRIPTION

The Discovery Tour is adaptable for your youth education group, and is designed to be modified for groups with a variety of ages (e.g. homeschool groups) or a group for which there is no existing Education Program (e.g. high school classes).

This flexible program includes:

- Introduction to the Gulf of Georgia Cannery and its history
- Canning Line Tour (choose machine or social history focus)
- 45 minutes of tailored programming chosen from modules
- Optional 15 minute film (grades 4-7) add on to make a total 105 minute program OR 25 minute film (grades 8-12) add on to make a total 115 minute program*

*note that some modules already include a film.
